

Foot Ball-Handling Design Your Game Assignment

- Each group will design an activity for foot ball handling skills.
- Each activity must include the rules of the game, what equipment is used, any scoring methods, and all other pertinent information.
- Each group will be given the opportunity to practice their activity, during class time.
- Each group will be given the opportunity to prepare for their presentation.
- Each group is required to complete the Group Design Follow-up sheet, bonus points for groups who submit a computerized form. (See website for template).
- Each group will pair up with another group and be given 8 minutes to complete their teaching.
- The participating group should be participating (playing) the game/activity.
- At the end of their teaching session, the participating group will assess the teaching group. Students are expected to assess appropriately.
- Assessments include:
 - Stated name of game and equipment needed
 - Described how to play clearly
 - Rules stated concisely & scoring method easily understood
 - Gave examples of proper ball-handling techniques
 - Provided a demonstration
 - Participants played game
 - Lesson was smooth and flowed
 - Each group member had a role, speaking part, &/or job
 - Overall lesson
