

# Basketball-Golf

Grade Level: 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade

National Standards:

Learning Objectives:

- The student will practice hand, ball-handling skills.
- The student will practice passing and shooting skills.
- The student will practice dribbling skills.
- The student will work in cooperative groups.

Space Needed:

- A gym, basketball court, blacktop, or any flat surface is acceptable.

Equipment & Materials Needed:

- Multiple cones to designate the playing area.
- Two (2) large cones.
- One (1) basketball ball per group of students.
- One (1) large bucket.
- Seven (7) square poly spots, or chalk to mark spots.
- One (1) medium soccer goal.
- One (1) lollipop.
- One (1) ball cart or large rectangular object.
- Three (3) rainbow sticks, or chalk to mark the ground.
- Markers to indicate the number of the hole.
- One (1) Basketball-Golf Score Card.
- One (1) Clipboard per group of students.
- One (1) writing instrument per group of students.

Set-Up:

- Place cones around the space, indicating the boundaries.
- Use Basketball-Golf Course Map as a model to set-up the course.
- Be sure to mark each hole with its corresponding number.
- Place the scorecard and pencil on the clipboard.

Description of Learning Activities:

- Students should be in pairs, triads, or foursomes.
- Students should be given instructions on how to fill-in the score card prior to playing.
- Teacher should walk through the course and demonstrate each skill at every hole prior to playing the course.
- Teacher should explain what max attempts and PAR means prior to playing the course.
- Begin each group at a different hole.

- The first player in the group takes their first turn, if she is successful; write the score down, if not, she goes to the end of the line and wait for her next turn.
- The second player in the group takes her turn, if she is successful; write the score down, if not, she goes to the end of the line and wait for her next turn.
- Continue this pattern until all students have taken their first turn; then repeat with the second attempts and so forth.

Course Holes:

Hole 1: Elbow Shot.

PAR 2-3 Max Attempts

Hole 2: 3 Pt. Shot.

PAR 4-6 Max Attempts

Hole 3: Power Slide.

PAR 1-2 Max Attempts

Hole 4: One Bounce, then In.

PAR 2- 4 Max Attempts

Hole 5: Backward, Over Head.

PAR 5- 6 Max Attempts

Hole 6: Block Shot.

PAR 1- 2 Max Attempts

Hole 7: Baseline Shot.

PAR 3- 5 Max Attempts

Hole 8: Pass BB through lollipop, into the net.

Hole 9: Free Throw.

PAR 2- 3 Max Attempts.

Authentic Assessment:

- Assess each group's scorecard to ensure they are scoring correctly.
- Observe the students' ability to work cooperatively in their groups.
- Observe the students' skill levels while they participate in the activity.
