

Hand Ball-Handling Choreographing Assignment

- The students will be in pairs. Students should self-select their partner based on the same ball handling skill level.
- The students will choreograph a dribbling routine which will consist of:
 1. Both hands must be used at some point during the dribbling routine.
 2. At least six (6) different dribbles (i.e. right-handed; between the legs; behind the back; cross-over; figure-8's; baby dribbles around left foot).
 3. Each dribble must be at least eight (8) counts.
 4. One (1) dribble must be a traveling dribble (moving from one location to another).
 5. One (1) dribble must be a mirror relationship dribble (following one another as if looking into a mirror).
- One (1) ball per student.
- Students may not pass the ball to one another.
- No other body parts may be used during the routine.
- Students will perform their routine in front of the class.
- The students will use a Peer Observation Form to assess each partner's routine.
